Salem Press Adds a Brand New Title to the Salem Health Series: *Community and Family Health Issues*

Edited by Amber Bruggman, LCWS and Kimberly Ortiz-Hartment, PsyD, *Community and Family Health Issues* is a three volume set that covers a variety of social, mental health, and physical conditions which can have a significant impact on the overall health and well-being of individuals, families, and communities. This title is designed to address three major areas that typically affect families and the community: **Biological Illnesses, Mental Health Difficulties, and Common Daily Stressors**. The goal of this three-volume work is to help break down the complexities of everyday life, give clarity to what so many of us struggle with, and provide help and support for navigating these difficulties.

The human experience is comprised of the most unique and complex of components. Some are common components to all human beings, some are choices, others are opportunities, and still others are viewed as miracles or tragedies. The complexities of what makes up an individual's life can be science or story. The science of psychology attempts to describe the diversity of occurrences one may face in a lifetime. *Community and Family Health Issues* is both a review of these complexities and their health affects as it is a guide. Topics have been divided loosely into a range of categories:

This new first edition comprises three volumes, 500 articles, and 23 major categories. In addition to material updated from other Salem Health titles, *Community and Family Health Issues* includes over 130 brand new articles, notably on current topics of vital interest to 13 to 21 year olds, their parents, guardians, and caregivers.

Articles in *Community and Family Health Issues* range from one to eight pages in length. Each begins with an italicized summary of the topic, and the text continues in clear, concise language,

thoughtfully punctuated with helpful subheads. All articles include a list of **Further Reading**, annotated for additional insight, and **See Alsos** to guide the reader to supplemental material throughout the work. *Community and Family Health Issues* also includes three appendixes and a general index. The appendixes include a **Glossary** of over 175 terms; **Categorized List of Contents**, which organizes articles according to 23 major categories; and a **Subject Index**.
