

# Careers in Medical Technology

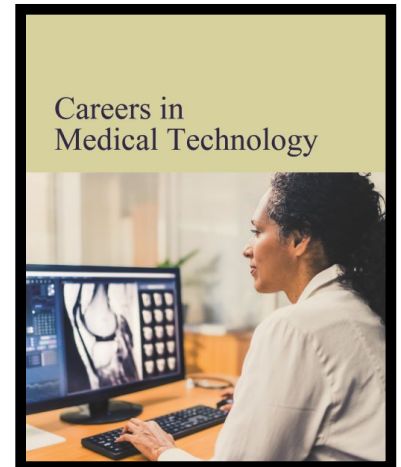

**“Gr 8 Up—Part of the extensive “Careers In” series, this volume provides a user-friendly guide to exploring professions in the dynamic and growing field of medical technology. Geared toward students, the book’s format highlights essential information, including salary expectations and job market demand, through concise snapshots of 26 profiles.** Readers can quickly scan these sections to see required degrees or certifications, helping them identify potential career paths. The text is enriched by fast facts from credible sources, providing context for each career and occasionally offering surprising insights about the field. Particularly engaging are the first-person interviews with professionals, including those just beginning their careers. These candid conversations share relatable journeys with missteps and less glamorous aspects of the job included, offering teens a realistic and encouraging look at the profession. Students may be familiar with some jobs, such as ultrasound technician and phlebotomist, as medical technology careers and be surprised to see that this field also includes epidemiologists and genetic counselors. Purchase of a print copy also includes free online access to the publisher’s database. **The balance of easy-to-skim highlights and in-depth exploration makes this an invaluable resource for students considering a future in healthcare.**
