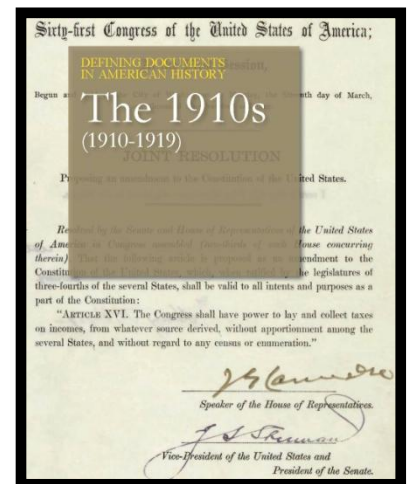


Defining Documents in American History: The 1910s (1910-1919)

“Editor Michael Shally-Jensen and 29 scholars produced this volume in Salem Press’ *Defining Documents in American History* series. It contains **38 documents** divided into six categories: Domestic Developments; The War Front; International Affairs; Labor and Immigration; Women’s Rights; and African American Affairs. Among the documents are the “Progressive Party Platform,” which was drafted for Teddy Roosevelt’s 1912 presidential campaign, “Emiliano Zapata: Plan of Ayala,” and “NAACP: Thirty Years of Lynching in the United States.” The supplementary materials accompanying the respective documents are organized according to the template utilized by the entire series. **One benefit of this work is that access to an online edition is provided with the purchase of a print copy. Public and academic libraries serving high school and undergraduate clientele would find this to be a useful reference tool.**”
