

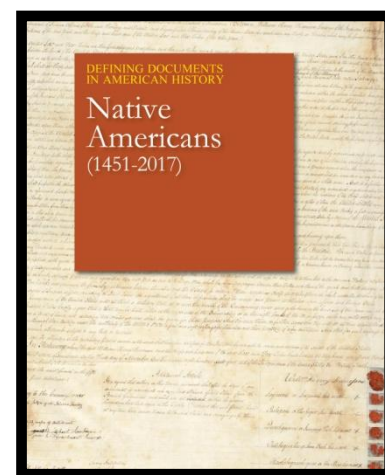
Defining Documents in American History: Native Americans
