This set is **well-organized**, with a variety of references and cross indexes. A complete essay list precedes each volume, more than five hundred black-and-white photos are included, and several appendixes list important events and individuals in a variety of contexts. Each entry in the set ends with an "Impact Statement" that summarizes major points of that entry. If the topic remained newsworthy into the following decade(s), a "Subsequent Events" statement is also provided. A time line for each year's major events in ten topic areas is an excellent jumping-off point for speech and essay assignments. Each entry also includes a short annotated bibliography. A thirteen-page annotated bibliography at the end of Volume 3, organized by thirteen topic areas, guides more extensive research in these subject areas...

Although I believe the target audience for this set is high school seniors and general readers, the **level of detail is admirable...**

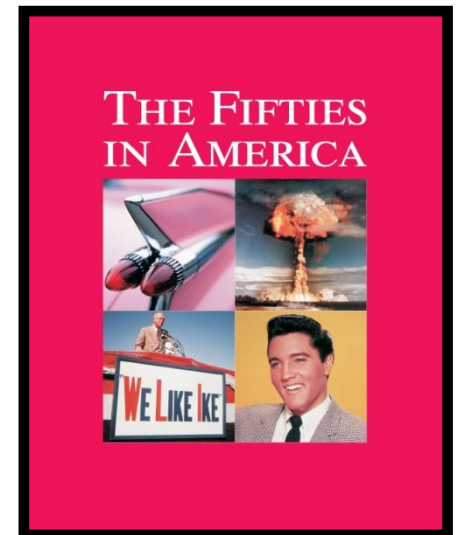
