In volume 2 are several appendixes: ‘Rulers and Heads of State’ by geographic location; a chronological list of entries in the volumes; a list of articles by category index, from *Archaeology* to *Women’s Rights*; and list of articles by country or region. The set concludes with an indexes of people and subjects.

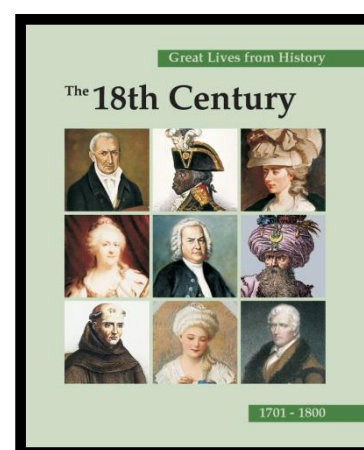
