

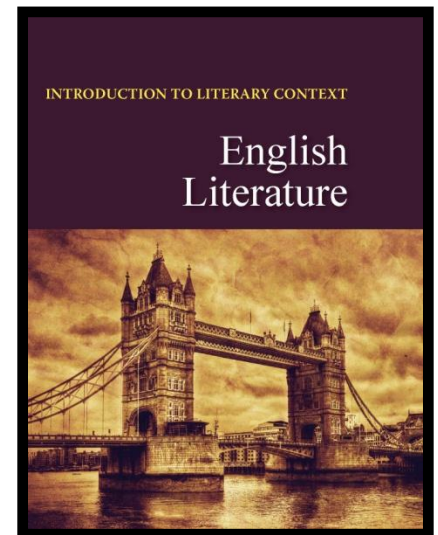
Introduction to Literary Context: English Literature
